Co-curricular Activities



CO - CURRICULAR

The College provides students with a whole range of co-curricular and extra-curricular activities to make their campus - life rich and meaningful and to develop them into fuller and more mature persons. It is mandatory that every student involves himself/herself in at least one of these activities for earning the single credit allotted for it

National Service Scheme (NSS):

NSS unit has been functioning in the college from 1998-99. This scheme is provided so that students learn to be men for others through service to the people around them. They have annual camps in villages in the district where they learn to relate with people, understand their difficulties and help them find solutions to their problems. Objectives:

- To provide social consciousness and commitment among the students by inculcating a sense of discipline and dignity of labour.
- To provide programmes for upliftment, service in rural areas, eradication of social evils and fostering adult education.

The membership is purely voluntary. A certificate of merit will be awarded at the end of the year, suitably recording the works to the credit of each member of the NSS units.

Citizen Consumer Club(CCC):

The Club Works on the motivational zeal of consumer groups to create awareness among students at a very young age and through them, the general public.

Objectives:

- ✓ To provide knowledge, attitudes and skills to make a person a better consumer.
- ✓ To create awareness among the students about consumer products and services, to use it with an ethical and environmental conscience.
- ✓ To help students know their rights and duties as a consumer.

Youth Red Cross (YRC):

The YRC was initiated for the purpose of providing service during emergency - times like war, floods and other natural calamities.

The major objective of YRC is to inculcate service habit among the youngsters. It aims at the promotion of Health and Hygiene among public.

Sports and Games:

St. Louis College has always given importance to sports and games. Students continue to distinguish themselves in sports and games, especially in Volley Ball, Football, Basket Ball, Throw Ball, Cricket and Athletics and they have been chosen for various professions in life.
